If a racer loses a ski more than two gates above finish (U629.4) they must exit course. If a competitor comes to a complete stop (e.g. after a fall), they must no longer continue through previous or further gates. This interdiction is valid in all events with a fixed start interval (DH, SG, GS). Only exception is for SL [661.4.1], as long as the competitor does not interfere with the run of the following competitor or has been passed by a competitor. [614.2.3] Penalty for continuing to race after a complete stop is disqualification. [628.8]. ALL knee braces and back protectors must be worn under the GS suit or race clothing. [614.2.2]. FIS approved helmets are required for GS & SG. Soft ear protection is only permitted for helmets used in Slalom. [807]. DQs will be posted on the Official Notice Board at the completion of each run. Protests will be allowed for 15 minutes after the posting of the DQs from each run. Protests not filed on time will not be considered (644) - Protest Fee \$50.00.













Registration, Lodging and other Info that might be useful

Note – Some folks have expressed interest in sharing a room with other campers or racers. If you are interested pop a note to racing@mamasters.org and we'll connect folks.

Hunter Mt has provided us with some discounts available for lodging at the slopeside Kaatskill Mountain Club, the rates are typically market rate so the earlier the better. You can get a 20% discount if you have an EPIC pass. The rates they gave us for the room block are around 10%, so the EPIC pass rate is much better. The room block at Hunter Mountain expires December 10, 2021. Studio with 1 queen bed. \$232 per night plus 8% tax and \$25 hotel fee per night. Breakfast is not included. Use Code: BHUMAM22. To reserve rooms at the group rate, call Group Reservations at: 855-332-1601 and follow the prompts to your chosen resort. There are a number of Airbnb's and area hotels that might offer more economical options.

- Hunter Mountain Brewery about 1 mile from entrance to Hunter (518 263-3300. Good food and craft beers. Thursday night is Sushi night.
- Jesse's Harvest House on east end of Tannersville. (518) 589-5445. Great food but expensive. They also have lodging there.
- Selena's Diner –in Haines Falls. (518) 589-0438. Typical diner food.
- Pancho Villas's in Tannerville (518) 589-5134 Great Mexican Food and margaritas.
- Jagersberg just outside entrance to Hunter. (518) 628-5788 German food but a bit pricey. Very good food.
